

EYELINER AFTERCARE

*Celluvisc Eye Lubricant
*A & D Ointment

What to expect:

You may experience swelling to a greater or lesser degree the day following your eyeliner tattoo. It is also normal for your eyes to feel slightly scratchy and sunburned following your procedure. This is normal and will dissipate quickly. Over the next week, fading and thinning of the color will occur. A percentage of the color that comes off is on the outer layer of the skin (epidermis). This is normal and to be expected. Some people do not lose much, others lose more. Although it is permanent, remember that your eyeliner will fade over time. The baseline average is 3-5 years. The average is 30-50%. Remember, everyone is different. Detail work, color strength, shape modifications and any finishing touches are done during your follow-up appointment. You must do your part to ensure long lasting results. Use good health common sense.

What to do:

Do not pick, rub, or try to peel at your eyeliner tattoo. Leave it alone for at least a week. If necessary, the area may be treated with a cold compress for 5-10 minutes as needed. Use a rewetting saline solution to keep your eyes lubricated and soothed as necessary. Wetter is better. You cannot harm them by keeping them lubricated. Use the eye drops I gave you to lubricate your eyes before going to bed after your appointment (*do not use while performing any daily activities as it can blur vision*). It also helps to sleep on several pillows to keep your head elevated for the first two nights. It aids in reducing swelling.

With a clean moist Q-Tip, apply some of the provided "A&D" ointment to the treatment area 2-3 times a day, being careful not to get any of the ointment in your eyes. Less is better. You may also use an eye rinse or eye drops the first day. Do not reuse the Q-Tips or apply any soiled object to the eye area.

Do not wear contacts for at least 24 hours after your procedure. It is OK to shower - water will not hurt your new eyeliner. In fact, rinsing the eyes in the shower is usually the easiest and best way to keep the area clean. However, do not go swimming, use saunas, hot tubs, or engage in *extremely* vigorous physical exercise for one week following your procedure. "Normal" exercise is ok. Do not use mascara, eyeshadow, etc., for one week following your procedure. After one week, use a new tube of mascara to avoid secondary infection. Use a gentle eye makeup remover as needed.
